## **Program Notes**

For the "beast" growing old has become more perplexing in recent years. His small group of friends has dwindled. Patrons once supportive of his creative pursuits have cast him aside for those younger and more disparate than him. He's often put in the mix with those who can no longer be trusted - corrupt politicians, predators and abusive authority figures. To many he's become obsolete, a social pariah. He uses his artistry to navigate his new role in the world, but realizes that each of his creations is like a message in a bottle that may never reach the shoreline. ## **Performance Notes**

Though metronome markings are provided, the performer should feel free to alter them and/or play sections rubato wherever necessary to make the piece as expressive as possible. Any changes to the piece leading to the best and most effective performance are always acceptable and most welcome. The quarter tones at the end of the piece need not be precise, only approximate. I consider this piece (and all of my music) to be a joint venture between the player and myself, as what I create only comes to life when it is performed by skilled artists

like yourself. I'm extremely grateful that you are considering presenting this work and greatly appreciate all of the many years of hard work and dedication you've invested in perfecting your skills as a performer.
